One of the most famous buildings in the world, the Tower of London has provided the setting for many of the great events and dramas in our Royal history. Guests can dine within this spectacular location and have the privilege of private viewings of not only the Crown Jewels but also the 700 year old Ceremony of the Keys, accompanied throughout by the famous Yeoman Warders.

There are several areas within the Tower of London that can be hired for a variety of events some of which are detailed below.

New Armouries - This large and elegant brick building was built in 1663-4 and was created as a new store for military equipment and supplies. Today the building has been fully restored and events take place surrounded by the military splendour of the building.

White Tower - The White Tower is the oldest medieval building at the Tower of London. It was built as a fortress and a residence but today houses part of the Royal Armouries – including the armour of Henry VIII and Charles I. This venue is ideal for reception drinks prior to a dinner in the New Armouries.

Wakefield Tower and St Thomas's Tower

Both the Wakefield Tower and St Thomas's Tower are perfect summer evening venues for a reception and dinner. With access to the wall walk, they provide spectacular panoramic views of the Tower and London.
