

Trinity House

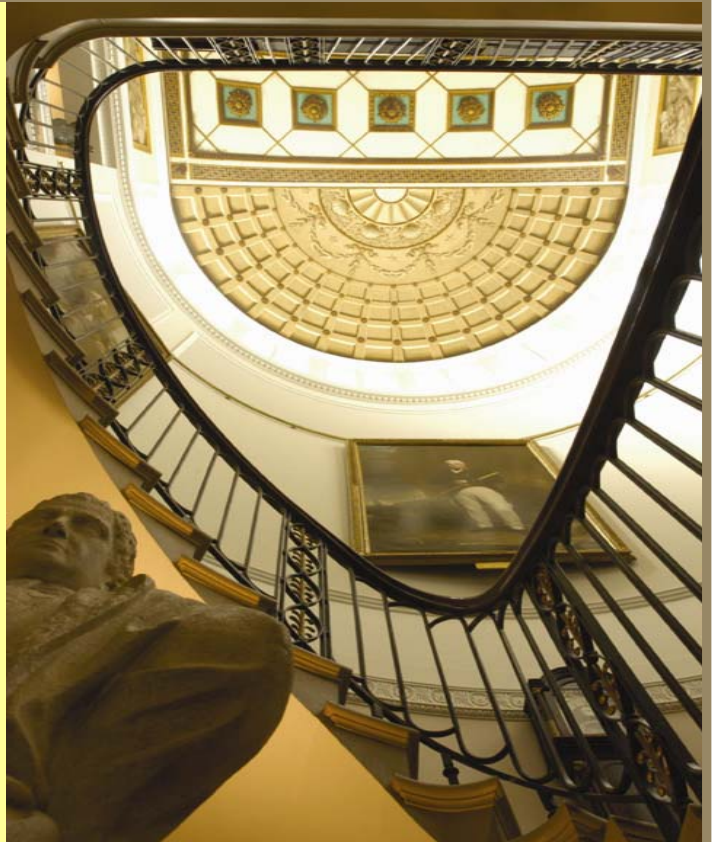
Trinity Square, London, EC3N 4DH

Trinity House, headquarters for the lighthouse service, was built in 1796. It has a unique and elegant suite of rooms in a tranquil city location overlooking Trinity Square and the Tower of London.

Trinity House has five rooms in a versatile town house environment. Shipwrights' models, Royal paintings, a fine painted ceiling and unique carpet along with the ships bell from the Royal Yacht Britannia assure a very special maritime atmosphere.

The flexibility of the surroundings make Trinity House suitable for a variety of events, including civil weddings, luncheons, dinner parties, board meetings, training courses and cocktail receptions, and all the while accommodating up to 120 guests in elegant comfort.

Stepping inside the front door guests are at once aware of breathing in history. There is a superlative example of a sweeping, twin curved Georgian staircase leading to the main choice of venues. The Court Room is commanded both by the ceiling's allegorical scene and the historical single-loom carpet. Moving through to the Library, an important collection of maritime books exists behind beautiful panelling.
