

York House

Twickenham, TW1 3AA

York House is a listed Grade II building and is scheduled as an Ancient Monument, dating from the 17th Century. Over the years the house has had many owners with each owner adding to the existing building and gardens. The house was bought by Twickenham Borough Council in 1924 and now forms part of the London Borough of Richmond Upon Thames Civic Offices.

With 4 rooms available for hire the venue offers a flexible space for intimate events through to larger celebrations & conferences. Two elegant rooms are licensed for Civil Marriage and Civil Partnership ceremonies, with a maximum capacity of 70 guests. Adjoining rooms are available for receptions for up to 200 guests.
