

**Middle Temple**  
**Middle Temple Lane, London, EC4Y 9AT**

Located in the heart of London's legal quarter, Middle Temple Hall is one of the four ancient Inns of Court. Middle Temple Hall was built between 1562 and 1573 and remains virtually unchanged to this day having survived the Great Fire of London and both World Wars. Middle Temple continues to service the legal profession today, and also houses some of the most imposing event space in London available for formal dinners, weddings, meetings, receptions, corporate events, garden parties and outdoor functions.

The main hall at Middle Temple is one of the finest examples of an Elizabethan Hall in the country with a double hammer beam roof carved from the oak of Windsor Forest and an elaborately carved screen made in 1574.

The traditional oak panelled walls are festooned with Coats of Arms and the impressive windows are made from heraldic glass memorials to notable Middle Templars.



Overlooking the river Thames, the award winning garden of Middle Temple Hall offers a peaceful haven from central London and makes for the perfect garden party or outdoor event.

The Bench Apartments comprise three additional rooms available for corporate and private events; the Parliament Chamber, Queen's Room and Prince's Room. The Queen's Room is perfect for a private dinner party for up to 22 or for a larger occasion the Parliament Chamber accommodates 70. The Bench Apartments can also be used as an area for drinks and canapés preceding a formal dinner in the Hall.
