Freemasonry is one of the world's oldest secular fraternal societies. A society concerned with moral and spiritual values.

One of the finest Art Deco buildings in England. Freemasons' Hall is now Grade II* listed internally and externally and available for all types of events.

The Freemasons' Hall is the headquarters of the United Grand Lodge of England and the principal meeting place for Masonic Lodges in London. Grand Lodge has been in Great Queen Street since 1775, the present Hall was built between 1927 – 1932 it is one of the finest Art Deco buildings in England.

The building is fully open to the public and a number of the rooms are available for hire including the Grand Temple (seating 1700), Boardrooms and Committee Rooms.

In 2003 the Freemasons Hall began its life as a venue available for hire.

Although the building was used in 1980s for filming it was only allowed in one or two areas, but with the partnership of Film London it then evolved and their resume now includes; Meetings and Conferences, Dinners and Awards, Parties, Concerts, Fashion Shows, Film Premieres, Receptions and Filming.
