Old Billingsgate Market is a landmark building situated in a prime position on the River Thames with views across to Tower Bridge, London Bridge and the South Bank. It is located on the doorstep of London's financial district with easy access to the West End. Originally a general market for corn, coal, iron, wine, salt, pottery, fish and miscellaneous goods, Billingsgate became famous for its fish market until recent times when it was restored as a venue offering the ultimate in flexibility for events.

Billingsgate has four areas, the largest of which is the Grand Hall on the ground floor. This venue boasts a grand 25 ft, triple height ceiling, double height windows on the south and north sides of the building ensuring there is a plenty of space and natural daylight to make this a perfect area for any dinner, reception, launch, award ceremony, conference or exhibition. There is a terrace which can be used for temporary marquees and also a vault area consisting of a network of interlinked brick arches suitable for receptions, parties, intimate dinners or as an unusual exhibition space. With effective lighting this area has a warm sophisticated atmosphere.
