The Louise Blouin Foundation is one of the capital's most innovative architectural space. The 35,000 sq ft former industrial building is set in a discreet West London location. The venue has been transformed into a ravishing contemporary arts space which offers exclusive and unusual spaces for events.

The London brick exterior has been beautifully restored preserving the original arched windows. The industrial interior has been stripped out, creating an unexpected state-of-the-art white space with a polished concrete floor. The dramatic façade of the building employs all 80 of the original arched windows to present a permanent light installation by legendary artist James Turrell. The windows, lit from within, create an ever-changing and colourful artwork which can be seen from afar.
