Few venues in the capital can rival a Livery Hall for prestige, splendour and an atmosphere of heritage. The Pewterers' Hall is several minutes walk from three underground stations in the heart of the City and therefore an ideal location and venue in which to hold an event.

The history of the Company reflects that of the use of pewter. For two centuries from 1474 pewter was unrivalled as a material for plates, dishes, drinking vessels and similar ware. Plates are on display in the Hall today that provide a unique record of pewterers of the period, and are of great historical value. With its flexible suite of rooms, Pewterers' Hall is a wonderful backdrop for meetings, conferences and presentations.

The first floor Court Room features panelling and chandeliers recovered from the previous Hall in Lime Street. It is hard to imagine a setting of more elegance for special committee meetings, luncheons, presentations or receptions.

The ground floor Livery Room, which lends itself to any occasion, is also available for events including luncheons, presentations, receptions or dinners.
